

CLIP THE BEGINNING SOUND

Build letter recognition, phonics, and fine motor skills with this fun clothespin activity!

MATERIALS

- Printed activity cards
- Laminator and laminating sheets (optional)
- Cardstock paper (recommended if not laminating)
- Clothespins
- Preparation
- Print and cut out the cards.
- For extra durability, laminate the cards. If you do not have a laminator, print them on cardstock instead.
- Gather enough clothespins for the activity.

HOW TO PLAY

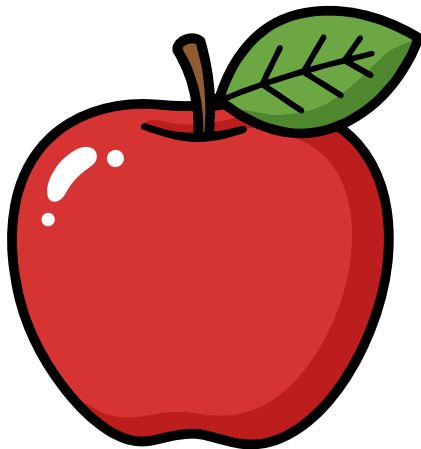
1. Each card features a picture and four letter choices. Ask the child to:
2. Name the picture.
3. Say the beginning sound of the word.
4. Find the letter that makes that sound.
5. Clip a clothespin onto the correct letter.
 - a. For example, if the picture is an apple and the choices are F, D, E, and A, the child should clip the letter A.

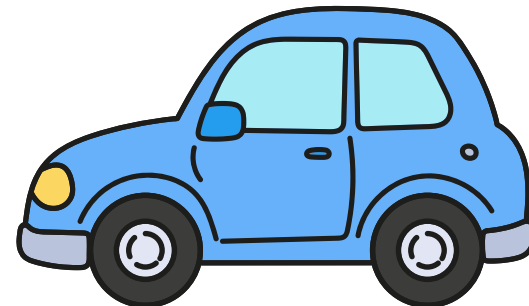

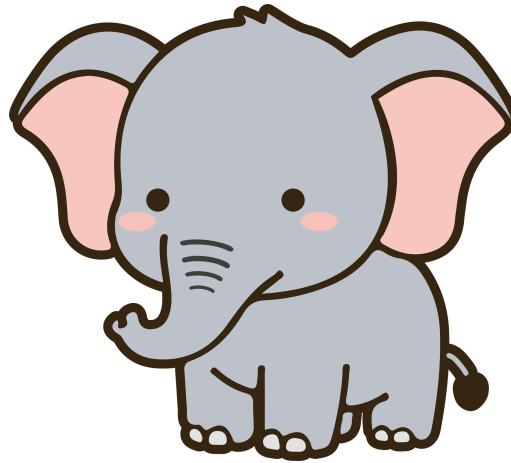
